

Designing an interactive activity with a mindmap

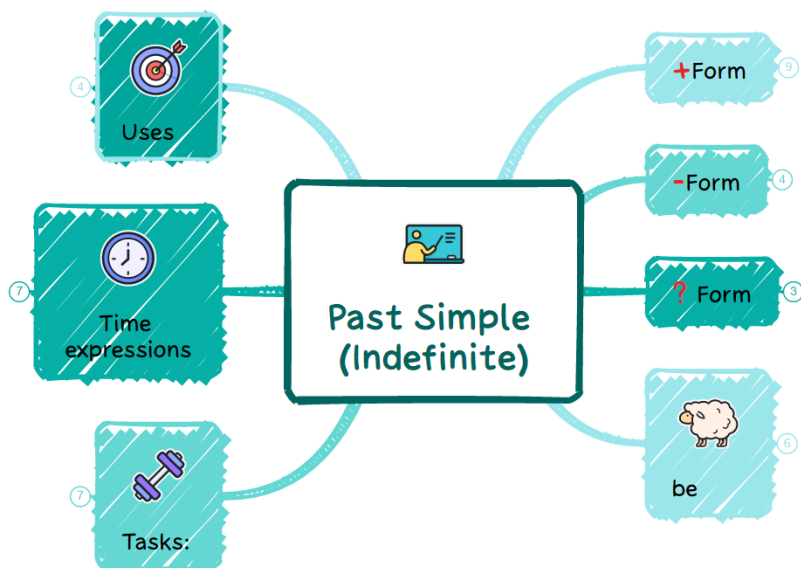

During the presentation stage of a lesson, a teacher introduces and explains the grammar rule to students, focusing on its meaning and form. The goal is to ensure that students understand and can use Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense correctly. The presentation stage sets the foundation for students to practice and produce the language in subsequent stages of the lesson.

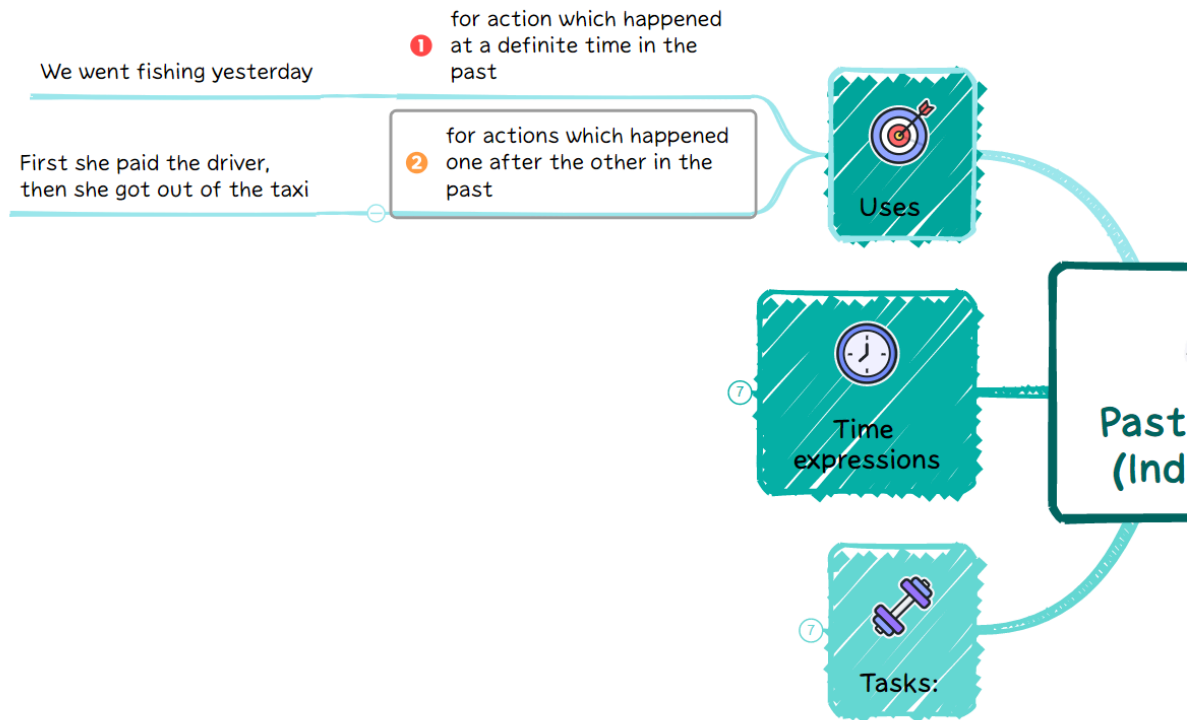
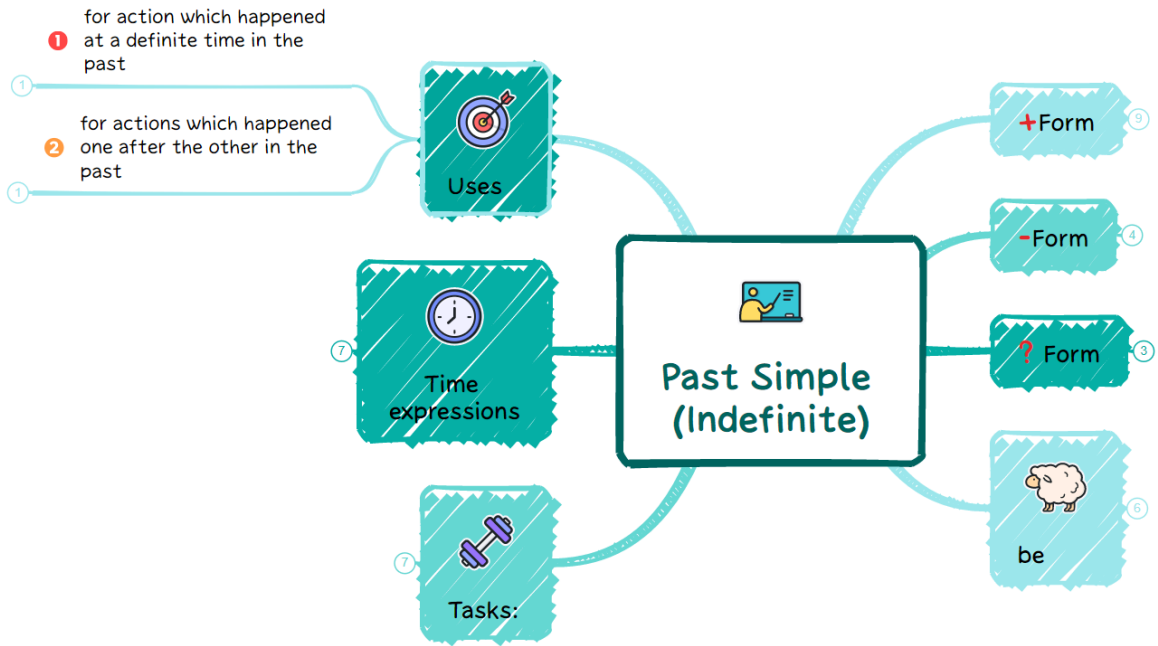


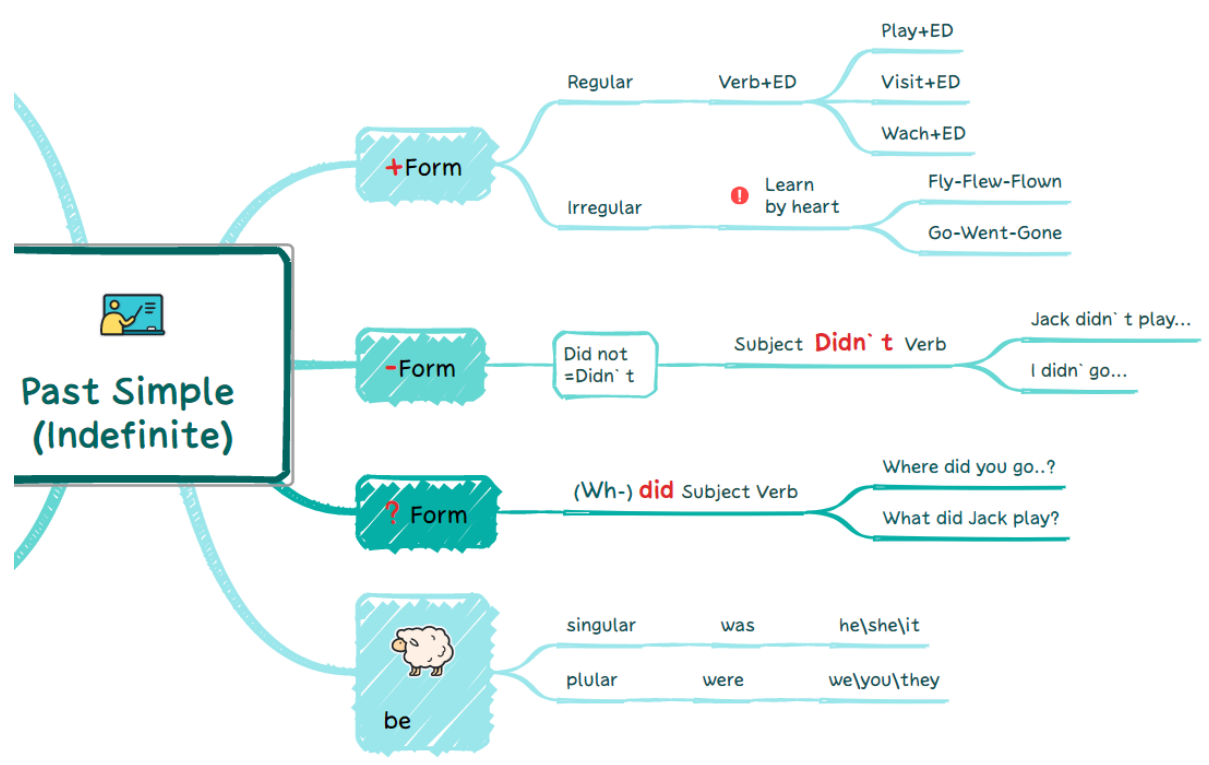
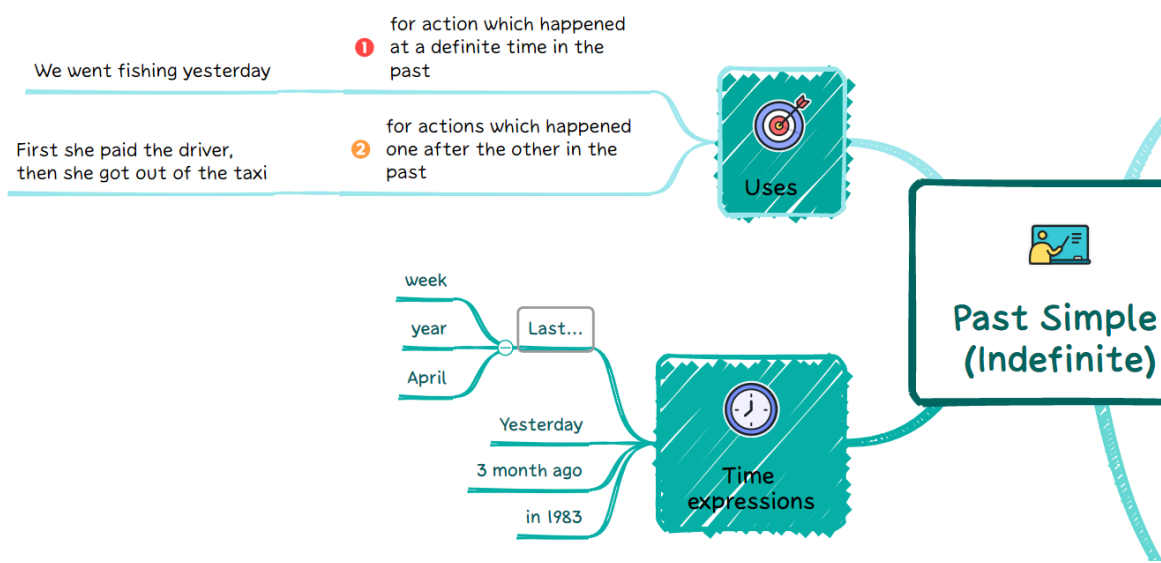
